Cucurbits such as Cantaloupe, Cucumber, Pumpkin, Zucchini, Watermelon, Melon, Muskmelon and Squash	Phytophthora Blight <i>(Phytophthora capsici)</i>	1 quart of Regalia® plus a labeled rate of a copper fungicide.	For suppression of Phytophthora Blight, apply Regalia® + a labeled rate of a copper fungicide preventively in 50-100 gallons of water per acre following transplanting or when the first symptoms of disease are visible. Repeat applications at 7-day intervals. Regalia® may be applied up to and including the day of harvest (0-day PHI). The use of Ridomil® Gold at transplant will improve control.

All applicable directions, restrictions and precautions on the EPA-registered label are to be followed.
